3. If you issued a yellow card and/or red card, check the box next to “USSF Misconduct Page 1”. If you issued a red card, you will also need to check the box next to “USSF Misconduct Page 2 Supplementary Report”. The blue text is link to download the report forms in Word format. Written Misconduct reports must be filled out and emailed to [assign@swisra.org](mailto:assign@swisra.org) within 24 hours. Referees who do not file their misconduct paperwork will no longer be assigned. If you have questions, ask.
4. Where guest players are allowed by the Rules of Competition, you are required to list them in the Comments section of the game report.
5. If you issue a yellow and/or red card, in addition to filing the written paperwork, you are required to state the details for each card in the Comments section of the game report. Refer to the LOTG for proper terminology. Sloppy writing is not professional.
6. If there is anything you want the league or assignor to know or you just need to vent, put it in the Comments. League representatives read all the Comments.
7. Click “Save”.

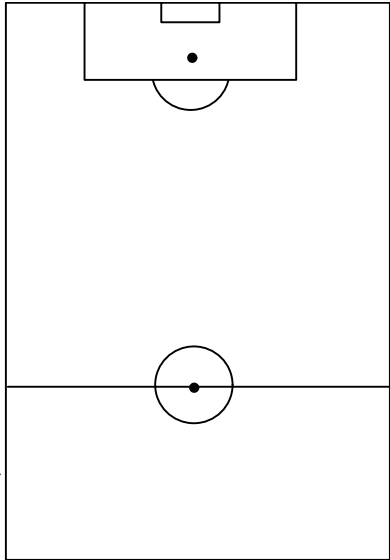

**Describe Any Unusual Incident:**

1. In the 78<sup>th</sup> minute with the score tied 1-1 and BNSC attacking, the Fusion goalkeeper came out 15 yards off her line. #22 for BNSC chipped the ball over the goalkeeper's head. The ball was heading directly into the goal when Fusion player #5, Erin Stop reach out and grabbed the ball with both hands preventing the ball from entering the goal. I immediately blew my whistle and indicated a penalty kick for BNSC Premier. I separated Fusion player #5, Erin Stop from the other players and showed her the red card for denying an obvious goal scoring opportunity by handling the ball. Fusion player #5 immediately left the field without further incident or comment. I observed her collect her gear and head towards the parking lot. Once she was observed leaving the immediate vicinity of the playing field, play was restarted with a penalty kick for BNSC Premier. BNSC Premier scored from the penalty kick.

2. In the 33<sup>rd</sup> minute, Fusion player #10 was spinting up field with no other players around her. She fell and immediately grabbed her right ankle and screamed in obvious pain. I did not witness the fall, but heard the scream. The ball had just left play over the touchline. I held the restart and went over to the injured player. The incident happened right in front of the senior AR. He told me that the player had fallen when no one was around her. The player was carried from the field and did not return to the game. The game was restarted with a throw-in. After the match had concluded, the Fusion coach advised me that the injured player had been taken to the hospital for x-rays by her father.
